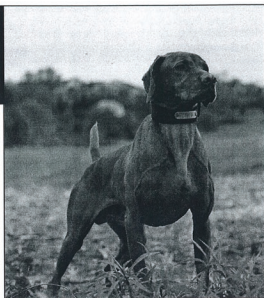


10 X CHAMPION FIELDWAYS JACK DANIELS

"The Best Of The Best"!

The legendary Fieldway's Jack Daniels is the most accomplished Vizsla Champion of all time. Whelped in May of 1990, Jack prior to his passing in April of 2001, won a grand total of 10 Championships. The most amazing feat is 4 of those 10 titles are National Championship wins. No other Vizsla has ever won 10 championships; in fact no other Vizsla besides Jack Daniels has ever won more than 2 National Championship titles. Fieldway's Jack Daniels is clearly the greatest Vizsla field dog on record.

Jack has also proven himself as sire. He has been a sire of a National Champion, 2 National Derby Winners, several Dual Champions, Field Champions, Amateur Field Champions, BOS VCA National Specialty, Multiple Sweepstake and Specialty Winner, Bench Champions-US and Canadian, Junior Hunters, Senior Hunters, Master Hunters, and Canadian Field Dogs. Jack was truly a great dog and his accomplishments are a true indication as to

why he should soon be nominated & elected into the Vizsla Hall of Fame.

Joseph Manning and John Frayne are the breeders of the famous Fieldway's Vizsla's from which Jack was acquired. The purchaser of this fine young prospect was Daniel Burjan. Daniel gave Jack to Carol Burjan when he was just a young pup. Carol was not a member of the Burjan family at that time, but rather one of Daniel's prized and generous clients. It was obvious that Daniel knew a good thing when it presented itself and somehow talked Carol into becoming his wife several years later. Carol fondly remembers with smiles and joy a remark made by Daniel's late father Dennis Burjan when Jack was gifted to her, "Honey, we're gonna get you a good dog". With no question about it, that is exactly what happened.

Jack was taken to greatness by the superb training and handling of Daniel Burjan. Daniel is the only trainer in history to have won National Championships with 3 different breeds of dogs. Daniel has won the Vizsla National Championship 6 times, 8 National Titles with German Shorthair Pointers, and 1 National Championships with a German Wirehair Pointer. Daniel has won or been runner-up in 107 American Field Championships or Classics. Daniel is truly a gifted trainer and handler.

Daniel and Jack were such an unstoppable and dominating team that they went 4 straight years of winning National Championship titles, however, Carol was the sole handler of Jack on finishing his AKC Amateur Champion title. Since Jack retrieved to hand better for Carol, she also handled Jack in the second series of the VCA Nationals, up until the VCA changed the rules of the game. The new rule implemented required the dog to be handled by the same person in both the first and second series.

Jack's famed career started in 1993 where he took a Runner-Up win in the Eastern Vizsla One Hour Classic as a mere 3 year old. The winner was 2X NAFC, DC, and AFC Masha's Best Flash Dancer a half

sister of Jack who was also handled by Daniel. The next year Jack returned to the Eastern Vizsla One Hour Classic and this time he was declared the winner. Jack finished his AKC Open & Amateur Champion titles in 1994 and later that fall won his first VCA National Championship in Clear Spring, Maryland - 1994 was a big year for Jack. The following year, 1995, was another excellent year. Jack repeated his performance with a win in the Eastern Vizsla Classic. Jack also captured the VCA National Championship in Keene, California for the second straight year.

In 1996, the Eastern Vizsla Classic became a Championship for the first time, and once again Jack showed his dominance by capturing this Championship. The 1996 NVA National Championship had moved to the Flint Hills near Eureka, Kansas. Jack showed he was a great competitor with a proven ability to adapt to the course before him to win the Championship. Jack

had now won Championships from every part of the country.

Jack added to his Championships by winning the Eastern Vizsla Championship in 1997. Jack also had another repeat performance in Eureka, Kansas to win the NVA National title. This was his fourth National Championship in four years. Jack's last 2 Championships were at the familiar grounds of the Eastern Vizsla Championship in 1998 & 1999. This made 6 straight years of winning the Eastern Vizsla Shooting Dog Classics and Championships. It was a request of domination that no other Vizsla has ever achieved. Fieldway's Jack Daniels passed away in April of 2001, just one month after his daughter Kal Cam's Gogirl won the NVA National Derby Classic and his son Kal Cam's Red Thunder won the prestige's NVA 2001 National Championship. Jack's legacy lives on.
